## TeleType Waypoints to Text Converter

The TeleType Waypoint to Text Converter converts TeleType GPS waypoints files (.way) from a binary proprietary format to a tab delimited text file suitable for importing into a database program for further analysis. The utility also converts a properly formatted text file into the TeleType GPS waypoint (.way) file. This Software runs on Windows 95/98/NT/2000/XP/VISTA.

#### **Converting Waypoints to Text:**

1. Activate the WaypointToText.exe program.
2. Select **WayPoints** → **Txt** as the type of conversion (Text -> Way will also be available choice, once you have converted waypoints to text you can go back and try to text to waypoints).
3. Select the waypoints file you wish to convert to text, for instance: "general.way".
4. Press **Open**.
5. Once the file has been converted to text, you will see the message, "Conversion Complete" with the file path where it has been saved. Press **OK**.

## **Converting Text to Waypoints:**

1. Activate the WaypointToText.exe program.
2. Select **Txt → WayPoints** as the type of conversion to convert a text file format into TeleType GPS waypoints.
3. Select the text file you wish to convert to a TeleType waypoint file, for instance: “general.txt”.
4. Press **Open**.
5. Once the file has been converted to a TeleType waypoint file, you will see the message, “Conversion Complete” with file path where the file has been saved. Press **OK**.

## **Manually Enter Points:**

1. Activate the WaypointToText.exe program.
2. Select **Manually Enter Points** as the option to create a waypoint text file to be converted into its TeleType waypoint file.
3. Type in the file name and the folder where the file has to be saved, for instance: “general”.
4. Press **Save**.
5. Fill in the Latitude (Required), Longitude (Required), WayPointName (Required), Note (Optional).
6. Press **Select an ICON**.
7. Press the icon logo which is to be given to that waypoint from the list of icons and press **OK**.
8. Now, press **Create**.

9. Once the file has been created at a specified destination, you will see the message “File has been written” with file path where the file has been saved. Press **OK**.

**Meaning of Fields:**

Longitude: degrees (- indicates West), fraction of degree

Latitude: degrees (- indicates South), fraction of degree

Name: name of the waypoint

Note: user-entered comments

Icon: user-entered icon.
